Hallelujah!

"Hallelujah" is a Hebrew phrase meaning *hallelu* (praise) and *YHWH* (the unspoken name for the Lord). For the grammarians... *hallelu* is a second-person, plural verb with intensive action, active voice, and imperative verbal function. For the rest of us: **we are commanded to join together and <u>REALLY</u> praise God!** Traditionally during the Lenten season, many Western Christian congregations refrain from saying "hallelujah" – instead, solemnly focusing on our need to turn back to God.

But as we spend these days attentive to God's constant presence in our lives, excitement wells up within us. As we turn toward the awesomeness of God, our joy becomes difficult to contain. The hallelujahs begin to seep through our lips.

So, my prayer for us this Lenten season is that our practices are fruitful and cause us to burst forth with hallelujahs by Easter morning (if not before)!



Woodstock Food Pantry


Woodstock Pantry buys many nutritional 'staples' which are always kept in stock which they purchase economically from the Northern Illinois Food Bank.

Most of the \$14.6 thousand favorable was due to the 2020 Budget included a payment of \$10,000 in January to the Presbytery Mission Grant, which has not been sent yet.

You might have noticed a few recent spikes in our sound system. Be assured it was not "operator error." The Sound/Video Team discovered a component in the control board has deteriorated and needs replacement. Since the sound board has exceeded it's expected operating life, we are researching the cost of replacing it with a new digital sound board and related components which will make operating sound and video much more efficient. Most importantly this will further improve your overall experience at Worship and other events in the Great Hall.

Also, please remember Per Capita for 2020 is now due. The per capita assessment for 2020 is \$38.47 (same as 2019) and is broken down as follows: General Assembly-\$8.95, Synod-\$3.81, Blackhawk Presbytery \$25.71. You may use the Per Capita envelope or make a note on your check or online payment. Thank you for your attention to this.
