#### A letter from Rev. Eric Corbin

#### The Hope of Resurrection

As April begins, we find ourselves drawing near to Holy Week. Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Sunday are just ahead. Each year, we walk this familiar road with Jesus—from the joyful hosannas to the solemn shadows of the cross—trusting that resurrection lies beyond. But we don't rush to Easter morning. We walk the path with care, letting each step prepare our hearts for the promise of new life.

This Easter, we carry both grief and hope. In recent days, our congregation has said goodbye to two beloved saints of the church: Tom Schwarz and Bob Boyne. These men were deeply rooted in faith and service. They offered their wisdom, kindness, and steady presence to this community in ways that shaped us all. We mourn their loss, and we give thanks for their lives, trusting that they are now held in God's eternal embrace.

Martin Luther once wrote, "Our Lord has written the promise of resurrection, not in books alone, but in every leaf in springtime." What a beautiful reminder that signs of new life are all around us—in the budding trees, in the warming days, and in the small acts of kindness that continue to bloom in our community.



#### Good Friday - April 18 at 8:00 p.m.


This solemn service will feature a reflective tone, as we remember the sacrifice of Jesus for us all.

WACM, a faith-based nonprofit, relies on volunteers and has several openings available.

The Direct Assistance Program (DAP) is looking for help with door duty and greeting applicants when they come to Grace Lutheran Church to request financial assistance from WACM, the Woodstock Area Community Ministries. In-person sessions of DAP are held on the first and third Thursday each month from noon-3pm at Grace Lutheran Church, 1300 W. Kishwaukee Valley Road, Woodstock, IL.

No sessions are scheduled on holidays.

Volunteers can help once or twice a month, depending on their availability.

Working directly with applicants to determine what assistance best fits their needs is another volunteer opportunity. Financial assistance in the form of vouchers is given after verification of a need is confirmed. Guidelines are followed concerning these requests for financial help. Volunteers meet with applicants monthly on the first and third Thursday from noon-3 pm at Grace Lutheran Church, Woodstock. Training is provided. Scheduling of volunteers is flexible each month, based on the individual's availability.

A board of directors makes decisions about WACM's policies. Each member church is entitled to have two representatives on the board, and First Presbyterian currently has an opening for a second representative. Meetings are held on the second Thursday most months of the year at 5:30 at First United Methodist Church of Woodstock.
